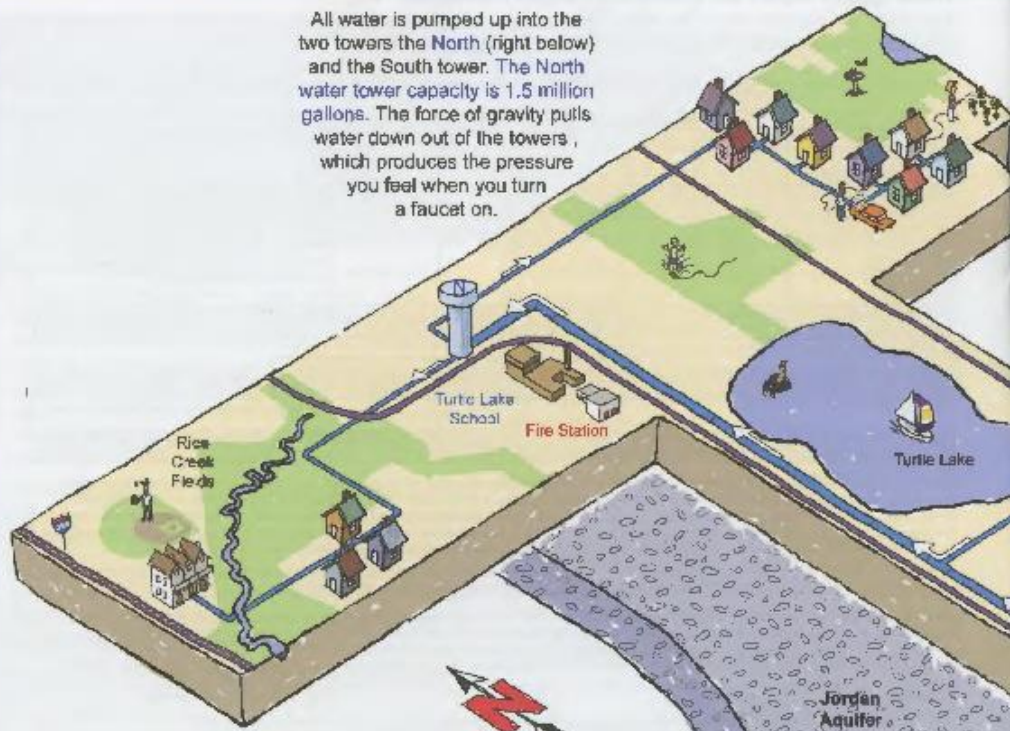


All water is pumped up into the two towers the North (right below) and the South tower. The North water tower capacity is 1.5 million gallons. The force of gravity pulls water down out of the towers, which produces the pressure you feel when you turn a faucet on.



**Where does Shoreview's water come from?**

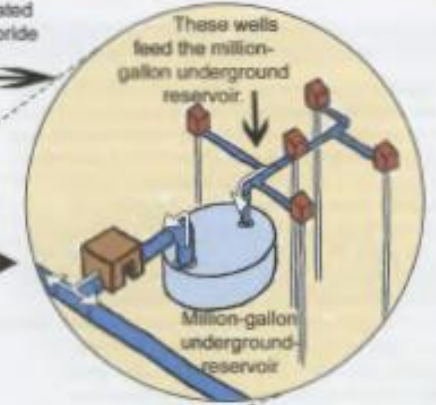
The process begins here! Our wells draw from the Jordan Aquifer, 400-500 ft below the surface.

At the booster station, water is treated with chlorine (to kill germs) and fluoride (for healthy teeth).

From the booster station, all water is pumped to either the North or South water tower.

This is a backup well used mostly in the summer for extra production. It has separate treatment equipment and pumps directly into the system.
